

Blue Spruce (PINACEAE)



(Nick B., Bend, Oregon) I had an immature Blue Spruce in front of my gardening supplies store for a couple of years that was doing OK, but should have grown much bigger in the amount of time it was out there. In fact I had been procrastinating transplanting it because there was still plenty of room in its pot to accommodate further root dispersal.

One of my customers suggested that I try adding some chelated trace minerals from Nevada he had just heard about (*PANÁK-ite*). If I liked the result he might consider distributing them under his own label. To make a long story short, I had nothing to lose, so I added a couple tablespoons to the pot, and two weeks later I couldn't believe the results.
